




THE ARCHITECTURE OF AUTHENTICITY


connection to this wonder. With preservation, sustainability and craftsmanship as guiding design principles, the architecture of Luštica Bay pays







The owner's ancestors were sailors and fishermen; their old photos hang on the walls of the restaurant along with fishing nets and weathered photographs of old stone houses from the owner's hometown of Muo. Fresh fish from this ultimate of seafood experts is a must have, as is gracamak, a local specialty, and the crispy sweet crunch of the frustula cake. The secret of Cesarica's gastronomic success lies in its traditional method of preparation, which dates back centuries. The restaurant prides itself on keeping things fresh and simple, providing diners with their

fill of the forgotten traditions, tastes and scents of Montenegrin history.

There's no better place to discover local history than Ćatovića Mlini (Catovic's Mills). Situated in a small village in Boka Bay, this restaurant provides a true Mon-

tenegrin culinary experience. Built around ancient water-driven flour mills, Ćatovića has been part of a family heritage for over two decades. Entering the restaurant, you can all but smell the rustic ambience, the touch

and feel of the historical mills set amidst beautiful lagoons. The stunning setting along with the authentic and delicious assortment of seafood will leave your taste buds savouring each and every bite—an experience that can only be described as mesmerizing.




